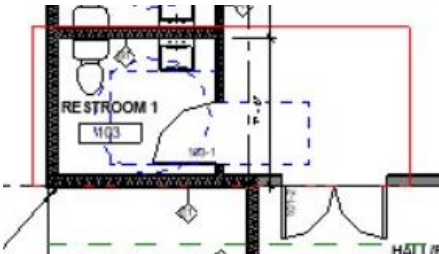

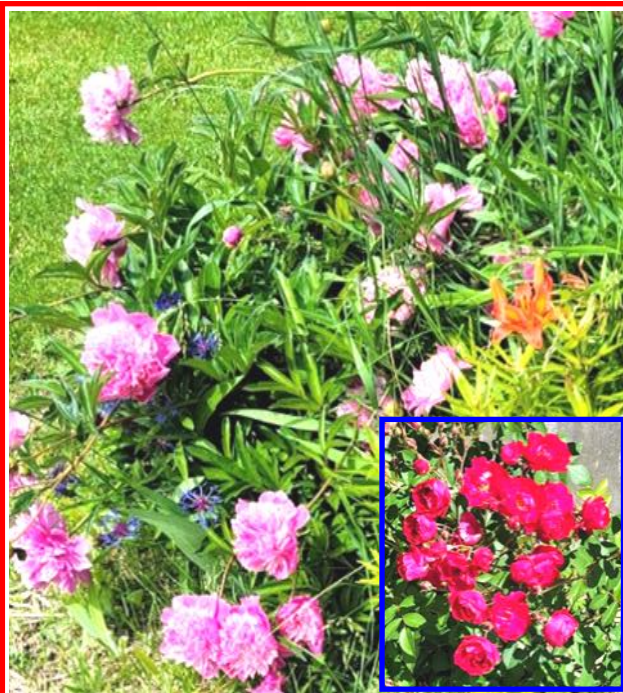
(cont.) up and usable now. It would be where the red line is on the drawing, just a little entry-way with the single bathroom. It would be the starting point for building on later after we figure out for sure how much more we want to build and just what we can afford. Since we would need a new electrical connection for the well pump, we would be able to provide power for hot water and heat in the new bathroom facility. We should have enough money in the bank now to do this much, especially if the new well is donated by H&L Drilling.



We have another sample of the kneelers with more foam (the one on the right) that you can try out. The general consensus seems to be that people prefer the “Steel Blue” vinyl covering for the kneelers, top right. The fabric to the left of it will be what we use on the Prei Deuxs. We will also have some padding made to match for all the chairs in the Sacristy. We have narrowed the carpet choices down to just a couple and are having some larger samples sent out so we can get a better look at them.



Checked with Willet Hauser and the stained glass windows ordered for the chapel are scheduled to be completed in August! So there is a chance we may be able to get them in before the cold weather sets in.

We will be undergoing an Audit in July. The last Audit was 10 years ago when Fr. Joe first came to the parish. As a small parish, we will likely receive a number of “findings” because we don’t have the staff to do everything that they would like us to do. Our qualified volunteers are limited also. For instance, we are supposed to rotate our money counters every week and people that are related shouldn’t be counting together. Kind of hard to do in a small town. We are supposed to have two unrelated people handling the money at all times. We do use tamper-proof security bags to discourage sticky fingers, but we don’t have enough volunteers to provide all the security that is asked for all the time. If you are willing to spend a few extra minutes after Mass we could use your help in watching and securing the collections better or helping with the counting, just let Fr. Joe know and he will get you started.

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Infant Baptism: Parents must be registered & active members of this parish or of another parish with family here in the parish (i.e., parents). Letter of permission from Pastor if parents are from outside the parish. Two Godparents who are registered and active members of their parish, one male and one female. Contact the Pastor before infant's due date to arrange date and time.

Holy Matrimony: Couples discerning this sacrament should contact the Pastor immediately after becoming engaged. NOTE: the diocese requires a minimum of 6 months advance notice regarding the intention to marry. Couples wishing to marry in the parish must be registered and active members of the parish, or individuals who have moved away whose parents are still active in the parish. Couples from other parishes must obtain a letter of permission to marry outside of their own parish.

Anointing of the Sick: Individuals who have been diagnosed as terminally or gravely ill or are preparing for invasive surgery should request this sacrament. Confession ordinarily proceeds receiving the sacrament of the sick, call the church office at 846-4114 to make arrangements.

Adult Confirmation, Adult Baptism (RCIA), and Adult Reception into Full Communion with the Church: If you, a family member, or a friend has not received the sacrament of confirmation, or are interested in being baptized into the Faith, or received into full communion with the Church, please contact the Pastor. Process will be discerned on an individual basis based on preparedness.
