

We just got our annual insurance bill from Catholic Mutual, and as expected it went up just over 8%. The total bill is \$41,417.00. The following is a

We did well on the audit and finished up going through all the paperwork the first day. Brian Mattern the auditor is working on his initial draft to send back for our comments. He said we had

one of the cleanest balance sheets and statement of activities that he has seen so far in his auditing efforts. We will have some challenges to make sure we get at least 2 signatures on documents so we are demonstrating adequate controls. Getting some additional volunteers to help with rounding up and counting the collections would be a good place to start. More will be shared when the audit comes out.

"This kind cannot be driven out by anything but prayer and fasting." (Mt 9:29) We are facing a great evil. Starting this Wednesday, the Bishops of Montana will be asking all Catholics to add fasting to our prayers to prevent CI-128 from taking hold in our constitution. There will be a number of hand-outs covering this in more detail in the coming weeks.

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Infant Baptism: Parents must be registered & active members of this parish or of another parish with family here in the parish (i.e., parents). Letter of permission from Pastor if parents are from outside the parish. Two Godparents who are registered and active members of their parish, one male and one female. Contact the Pastor before infant's due date to arrange date and time.

Holy Matrimony: Couples discerning this sacrament should contact the Pastor immediately after becoming engaged. NOTE: the diocese requires a minimum of 6 months advance notice regarding the intention to marry. Couples wishing to marry in the parish must be registered and active members of the parish, or individuals who have moved away whose parents are still active in the parish. Couples from other parishes must obtain a letter of permission to marry outside of their own parish.

Anointing of the Sick: Individuals who have been diagnosed as terminally or gravely ill or are preparing for invasive surgery should request this sacrament. Confession ordinarily proceeds receiving the sacrament of the

sick, call the church office at 846-4114 to make arrangements.

Adult Confirmation, Adult Baptism (RCIA), and Adult Reception into Full Communion with the Church: If you, a family member, or a friend has not received the sacrament of confirmation, or are interested in being baptized into the Faith, or received into full communion with the Church, please contact the Pastor. Process will be discerned on an individual basis based on preparedness.
